



Frequently Asked Questions of Keep North Carolina Beautiful (KNCB) Bourbon & Spirits Raffle

1. What is the age of entry for the raffle?

All participants must be 21 years of age or older.

2. May I purchase more than one ticket?

YES. The more you purchase, the better your chances as no purchase limit applies. While sufficient tickets are available; a maximum of 999 tickets will be sold, although the actual number sold is likely to be significantly less.

3. Can I enter the raffle if I live outside the state of North Carolina?

Yes, as long as it's not prohibited by law in the state you live.

You are welcome to enter the raffle contest in a state outside of North Carolina by making a donation to KNCB on or before Thursday, September 12th. All donors, of \$100 or more, prior to the deadline will automatically receive a raffle ticket number assigned to them for entry into the raffle. Tickets will be assigned with the value of 1 ticket per every \$100 donation. Any prizes won outside the state of North Carolina cannot be shipped by law. As such, you must make plans to pick up your prize winnings no later than 45 days after the contest drawing. All prizes that are not claimed by then will be held by KNCB for re-use in the 2025 raffle drawing.

4. Do I need to be present to win?

NO. There will be a LIVE drawing held by a certified auctioneer on Saturday, September 14, 2024 at 10:30 PM EDT in Greensboro, NC at the Grandover. Within 72 hours of the drawing, all results will be posted on the KNCB Bourbon Raffle Webpage:

5. What happens to the raffle proceeds?

All net proceeds of this raffle will benefit Keep North Carolina Beautiful's mission, K-12 environmental educational grants, and support operational programming and beautification projects throughout the state of North Carolina. Advertising for raffles, bourbon purchases, tickets, and costs associated with delivery to the winners are all expenses associated with our bourbon raffles and are also paid for by bourbon raffle proceeds.

6. Is KNCB licensed to offer this raffle?

Yes, KNCB applied and has been awarded a State of North Carolina Special One Time Permit (Permit #: T00343140) tendered by the State ABC Commission, for usage on Friday, September 13, 2024 – Sunday, September 15, 2024.

8. Are your bourbon and/or spirits donated?

Some of the bourbon listed in the prize awards is donated thanks to several of our sponsors. However, most of the bottles we raffle is purchased by KNCB. We must comply with state regulations that require our spirits to be purchased from retailers, wholesalers, or distillers licensed in the state of North Carolina.

9. Why are the winning tickets chosen from a tumbler instead of electronically?

Though not a specific law in the state of North Carolina, many states have policies around the use of sequentially numbered paper tickets and the use of a traditional tumbler. As other states do, we too will use a tumbler to draw winners from the tickets entered into the raffle. We will track the tickets allocated to donors and the raffle tickets purchased between Friday, September 13th at Noon and Saturday, September 14th at 10PM on a ticket log; which will be visible on our website beginning on Friday, September 13th at 1PM. The ticket log will be updated twice daily with the final update being at 10PM on Saturday, 30 minutes prior to the raffle drawing. Each ticket number shown on the excel spreadsheet of assigned owners of the tickets will correspond with a numbered paper ticket that will be placed in the tumbler prior to the drawing. This seems the most equitable and honest way to facilitate the raffle. A third party, licensed auctioneer, will conduct the raffle live in front of over 200 guests on Saturday, September 14th at 10:30PM. Winners will be posted by Noon on Sunday (15th), if not before.

10. How do the winners receive the bourbon/spirits? All winners who are not on site at the time of the drawing will need to schedule pick-up/delivery of their prizes in the state North Carolina with the KNCB staff. Prizes must be claimed before December 31, 2024. Any prize not claimed will remit to Keep North Carolina Beautiful to be utilized in a 2025 raffle or auction.

DISCLAIMER: Must be 21 years or older to enter and must reside in the contiguous 48 US States. The drawing to be conducted live at the KNCB fundraising dinner on September 14, 2024 at approximately 10:30 PM EST. All winners will be announced at that time, and subsequently posted to the KNCB "1st Annual Bourbon & Spirit Raffle" webpage. An email receipt for your donation and/or purchase of raffle ticket(s) will be sent within 48 hours of your purchase. Ticket numbers will be displayed on the purchased ticket log on our website and physical raffle tickets will not be mailed. Physical raffle tickets may be purchased between 1PM on Friday, September 13th through 10PM on Saturday, September 14th at the 38th Annual KNCB Golf Tournament at the Grandover in Greensboro. The winners will also be notified by email no later than Tuesday, September 17, 2024. No tickets will be sold directly to KNCB employees. No purchase limit applies, and while sufficient tickets are available; a maximum of 999 tickets will be sold; although, the actual number sold may be significantly less. Void where participation is prohibited. All proceeds benefit Keep North Carolina Beautiful, a North Carolina 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
