THE GOLF PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice rounds are available at special rates on all Pinehurst courses on Friday, tee time availability will vary, so call early! KNCB attendees staying on property can play PINEHURST NO. 2 for a Special Rate of \$255 per player on Friday!

THE GREEN DIVISION

We know some people still play golf for fun! For teams where some players do not have certified handicaps: all players must provide handicap information or scorecards so that a handicap can be assigned before play. Certified handicaps should be provided if available.

We will re-flight teams after Day 1! This year's handicap format:

Saturday - Course No. 1 Shotgun Start at 8:00 am

Texas Scramble: Each player drives on all 18 holes. Captain chooses the best shot. Each player then plays from that spot and plays their own ball until holed. The lowest gross score of the four is used on each hole. The final team score for the round will be adjusted based upon a portion of the aggregate of the individual player handicaps.

Sunday - Course No. 8, Shotgun Start at 8:30 am

Best Ball: Each player plays own ball from tee through the green. The lowest gross score of the four is used on each hole. The final team score for the round will be adjusted based upon a portion of the aggregate of the individual handicaps.

The Clean Division Certified handicaps are required

Teams have four players and switch course for second round.

Saturday - Course No. 1 Tee Times start at 8:30 am

Sunday - Course No. 8 Tee Times Start at 8:00 am

Format is two low-net best ball both days: Each team will be provided a scorecard with the appropriate handicap stroke allocation for each player. Each player plays their own ball for the entire hole. After each hole, gross scores are recorded next to each player's name. Net score is determined by subtracting handicap strokes from individual's gross score. Two lowest net scores per hole will be used as the team score for that round.
